<p>___ <b>International Scenario Writing rules followed:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must contain identical content to the Scenario submitted to Affiliate competition</li> <li>• 1500 words or less (does not include title of scenario) <b>Words that exceed the 1500 limit will be removed from the end of the scenario by the International Office and not provided to evaluators.</b></li> <li>• Submitted in English for evaluation The 1500 word count may be based on the English translation or the original language; it is the student's choice. If word count is based on the original language then a copy of the scenario in the original language must be submitted, along with the English translation.</li> <li>• Set at least 20 years in the future</li> <li>• Recognizable relationship to a valid FPSPI topic (PP1, PP2, QP, AB, appropriate IC)</li> <li>• 12 point font (readable, not script)</li> <li>• Scenario title on first page</li> <li>• No mention of author's name, school, or Affiliate Program within scenario</li> </ul>	<p><b>Student, Coach, Affiliate Director</b></p>
